FROM HAMON-GOG TO ARMAGEDDON

If you're really looking for the truth about the end times, you'll want to know the difference between Hamon-Gog and Armageddon. Hamon-Gog is a battle of the sons of Noah, and Armageddon is a battle among <u>all</u> the creation of God. By God's accounting, there must be at least seven or eight years between the two battles, depending upon when the new temple in Jerusalem is built and functioning.

SIXTH SEAL / BATTLE OF HAMON-GOG

Israel will be attacked by Gog, the leader of Magog, a country to Israel's uttermost north.

- Gog of the land of Magog, the prince of Rosh [Russia?], Meshech [Moscow?], and Tubal [Tblisi?] Ez 38:2
- in the latter years you will come into the land that is restored from the sword ... Israel ... brought out from the nations ... I have brought them ... out of their enemies' lands ... I am the LORD their God Ez 38:8; 39:27-28
- you will come ... out of the remote parts of the north ... in the last days Ez 38:15-16

But God will intervene and bring about the destruction of Gog and his armies. Israel will burn their enemies' weapons for seven years, and bury their dead bodies for seven months.

- there shall be a great shaking in the land of Israel ... mountains ... steep places ... every wall shall fall to the ground Ez 38:19-20
- pestilence ... blood ... great hailstones ... fire ... brimstone Ez 38:22
- Israel shall go forth, and ... burn the weapons ... with fire seven years Ez 39:9
- there shall they bury Gog and all his multitude: and they shall call it the valley of HAMON-GOG. Ez 39:11
- And seven months shall the house of Israel be burying of them, that they may cleanse the land. Ez 39:12

At Hamon-Gog, God will cause fire to hit Gog's country as well as the isles and coastlands (the U.S. and others). This will be a nuclear holocaust that brings untold millions of deaths.

 And I shall send fire upon Magog and those who inhabit the coastlands in safety; and they will know that I am the LORD. Ez 39:6



The Battle of Hamon-Gog coincides with the Sixth Seal of Revelation...

- sixth seal ... sun ... black ... moon ... blood Rev 6:12
- stars of heaven fell unto the earth ... as a fig tree Rev 6:13
- mountain and island ... moved Rev 6:14
- mountains and rocks, Fall on us ... hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb Rev 6:16

The Battle of Hamon-Gog is only the beginning of God's end times judgment. The story is not over. Yet to come are seven years of Trumpets and Bowls, and the Battle of Armageddon...

TRUMPETS & BOWLS

Seven Trumpets are to be blown and seven Bowls are to be poured. They match in order from 1 to 7. You will find the Trumpets in Revelation chapters 8-9 and the Bowls in chapter 16.

Trumpet 1 (T1) / Bowl 1 (B1)

- upon the earth ... third ... of trees ... all green grass ... burnt Rev 8:7
- grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast Rev 16:2

T2 / B2

- great mountain burning with fire ... third ... of the sea became blood Rev 8:8
- third ... creatures ... in the sea ... died ... third ... ships ... destroyed Rev 8:9
- upon the sea ... it became ... blood ... every living soul ... in the sea ... died Rev 16:3

T3 / B3

- great star ... fell upon ... rivers, and ... fountains of waters [fresh waters] Rev 8:10
- star ... called Wormwood ... waters ... became wormwood ... many men died Rev 8:11
- rivers ... fountains of waters ... became blood Rev 16:4

T4 / B4

- sun ... moon ... stars ... darkened Rev 8:12
- sun ... scorch men ... with great heat ... they repented not Rev 16:9

Around T4/B4 is the midpoint when the antichrist stops sacrifices and sets up his image in the temple in Jerusalem. When these events happen, you know there are 3.5 years to go.

- by him the daily sacrifice was taken away Dan 8:11
- "in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering; and on the wing of abominations will come one who makes desolate" Dan 9:27
- "And forces from him will ... do away with the regular sacrifice. And they will set up the abomination of desolation." Dan 11:31

The three remaining Trumpets are the three woes...

• Woe, woe, woe ... of the three angels, which are yet to sound Rev 8:13

T5 / B5 / First Woe

- a star ... which had fallen ... key of the bottomless pit Rev 9:1
- sun and ... air were darkened Rev 9:2
- locusts ... not hurt ... grass ... green thing ... trees ... only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads Rev 9:3-4
- not kill them, but ... tormented five months Rev 9:5
- men seek death ... death shall flee from them Rev 9:6
- [description of helicopters] crowns like gold ... faces of men ... hair ... of women ... teeth ... of lions ... breastplates ... iron ... their wings ...



sound of chariots ... tails like ... scorpions ... hurt men five months ... king ... angel of the bottomless pit $\,\mathrm{Rev}\,9{:}7{-}11$

- seat of the beast ... was full of darkness Rev 16:10
- blasphemed ... God ... because of their pains and their sores Rev 16:11
- One woe is past ... two woes more Rev 9:12

T6 / B6 / Second Woe

- Euphrates ... slay the third part of men Rev 9:14-15
- Euphrates ... dried up ... kings of the east Rev 16:12
- the number of the armies ... was two hundred million Rev 9:16
- [description of tanks] heads of lions ... fire ... smoke ... brimstone ... tails ... like unto serpents ... heads ... do harm Rev 9:17,19
- the third part of men killed Rev 9:18
- second woe is past ... third woe cometh quickly Rev 11:14

All of the preceding events must take place before the Lord's return at the 7th Trumpet.

The 7th Trumpet/Bowl is Armageddon — the final battle. While Hamon-Gog is a war among mankind, Armageddon will involve not only mankind, but also heavenly beings — both good and evil — and even the Lord Himself.

T7 / B7 / Third Woe

- Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling ... a burdensome stone for all people
 ... all the people of the earth be gathered together against it Ze 12:2-3
- For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle Ze 14:2
- I will ... gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley ... there will I sit to judge all the heathen Joel 3:2,12
- And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue ARMAGEDDON. Rev 16:16
- Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations Ze 14:3
- in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets. Rev 10:7
- For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. Lk 21:22
- And the seventh angel sounded; and there arose loud voices
 in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become
 the kingdom of our Lord, and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever." Rev
 11:15
- And the seventh angel poured out his bowl upon the air; and a loud voice came out of the temple from the throne, saying, "It is done." Rev 16:17
- the Ancient of Days came Dan 7:22
- at the last trump 1Cor 15:52
- For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God 1Th 4:16



- Jesus ... shall ... come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven ... from the mount called Olivet Acts 1:11-12
- his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives Ze 14:4
- he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth ... And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth Rev 10:2-3
- The sun and the moon shall be darkened, and the stars shall withdraw their shining.
 The LORD also shall roar out of Zion ... and the heavens and the earth shall shake
 Joel 3:15-16
- For it will be a unique day which is known to the LORD, neither day nor night, but it will come about that at evening time there will be light. Ze 14:7
- For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. Mt 24:27
- And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn Mt 24:30
- they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn Ze 12:10
- they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power Mt 24:30
- And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called THE WORD OF GOD.
 - And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations ... And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS. Rev 19:11-16
- And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army. Rev 19:19
- And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great. Rev 16:18
- And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. Rev 16:20
- And huge hailstones, about one hundred pounds each, came down from heaven upon men; and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, because its plague was extremely severe. Rev 16:21
- the great wine press of the wrath of God ... And the wine press was trodden outside the city, and blood came out from the wine press, up to the horses' bridles, for a distance of two hundred miles. Rev 14:19-20
- Now this will be the plague with which the LORD will strike all the peoples who have gone to war against Jerusalem; their flesh will rot while they stand on their feet, and their eyes will rot in their sockets, and their tongue will rot in their mouth. Ze 14:12
