God's Definitions

Do you know how The Father thinks and speaks?

Revelation 19:13

¹² ...He has a name written which no one knows except Himself. ¹³ And He is clothed with a robe dipped in blood; and His name is called The Word of God. **His Name** — His Name is <u>The Word of God</u>. The most important thing to God is His Word. It is His Name, which He also gave to His Son (John 17).

Luke 18:19

¹⁸ And a certain ruler questioned Him, saying, "Good Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?" ¹⁹ And Jesus said to him, "Why do you call Me good? No one is good except God alone." **Good** — "Good" equals <u>God</u>. Therefore, "good works" means God works. This is also why you must learn what is good and what is evil from God the Father, through Moses and the Prophets; because God alone is good.

1John 4:8

⁸ The one who does not love does not know God, for <mark>God is love</mark>.

Romans 10:17

¹⁶ But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report? ¹⁷ So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Mark 13:10

¹⁰ And the gospel must first be published among all nations.

Love — "Love" equals <u>God</u>. If you don't have God, you have nothing and are nothing (1Cor 13). God loved the world by giving Himself to the world as Jesus of Nazareth. The Word was God.

Faith — "Faith" comes from hearing the Word of God. If your faith comes from anywhere else, you're worshipping in vain.
Your faith cannot rest on the wisdom of men.
True faith comes only from God's Word and only as taught by Him.

Gospel — The "gospel" is <u>the Word of God</u>, <u>all 66 books</u>. Jesus preached the gospel, and God published His gospel to all nations. He sent the Bible to the whole world.

If you will look for God's meanings instead of trusting man's thoughts as you read the Word of God, the Bible may begin to open for you in a new way.
