## The Write to Life...

The Author and Creator of Life is also the Author of a Book – the Bible. It is the Word of God, which He caused to be scribed, assembled, and published.

The tablets of the Law were written by the very finger of God, and the first five books of the Bible were dictated by God to Moses.

The Word of the Lord came to the Prophets and directed them to inscribe the warnings, promises and mysteries of God for the ages to come.

The Word of God was sent in the flesh, where He lived by the Law of God, spoke only the words of the Father to His creation, and wrote with His finger in the dust of the earth.

After He died, was resurrected, and ascended to Heaven, He sent His Spirit of Truth to inspire the writing of the New Covenant, to bring to mind all the words that He spoke, and to write His Law on the hearts of those who believe and fear His name.

...and He has a **Name written** which no one knows except Himself.

And He who sits on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." And He said, "Write, for these words are faithful and true." (Rev. 21:5)

"Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, 'Write all the words which I have spoken to you in a book.'" (Jer. 30:2)

"Take a scroll and <u>write</u> on it <u>all the words which I have spoken</u> to you concerning Israel, and concerning Judah, and concerning all the nations" (Jer. 36:2)

And when He had finished speaking with him upon Mount Sinai, He gave Moses the two tablets of the testimony, <u>tablets of stone</u>, <u>written by the finger of God</u>. (Exod. 31:18)

"These <u>words the LORD spoke</u> to all your assembly at the mountain from the midst of the fire, of the cloud and of the thick gloom, with a great voice, and He added no more. And <u>He wrote them on two tablets</u> of stone and gave them to me." (Deut. 5:22)

And it came about, when Moses <u>finished writing the words of this law in a book</u> until they were complete (Deut. 31:24)

"However, I will tell you what is inscribed in the writing of truth...." (Dan. 10:21)
