Language

Just as a little child would learn the language of his/her human parent, someone beginning to learn from the Lord needs to learn His language, how He speaks. For example, He calls His people "sheep," "wheat," or "good trees." People who aren't His can be "goats," "chaff," or "bad trees." The Lord uses this kind of figurative language all throughout His 66 books, and all of it is important to Him. You can either learn the Lord's tongue from Him or deal with the babble of men's teachings.
